HOW TO CONVERT A KLEIN TOOLS 6-POINT SUSPENSION FOR 4-POINT COMPATIBLE KLEIN TOOLS HARD HATS







LOCATE THE ANCHOR SLOTS Verify that your hard hat has the 2 side anchor slots. If NOT, then proceed to convert the 6-point suspension.



CONVERSION TO 4-POINT SUSPENSION Reattach the sweatband on to the suspension.



STORE THE CENTER STRAP FOR FUTURE USE



SUSPENSION
Detach the old
suspension in the hard
hat. Remove and save
the sweat band and top
pad, set aside. Discard
the old suspension.

REMOVE EXISTING



REINSTALL THE SUSPENSION INTO THE KLEIN HARD HAT Secure the modified 4-point suspension back

into the hard hat shell.



STRAP AND STRAP DISK Identify the center strap that connects through the strap disk. See suspension image on top.

LOCATE CENTER



REATTACH THE TOP PADEnsure the top pad sits properly.



REMOVE THE CENTER STRAP Slide the center strap through the slots of the strap disk.



VERIFY INSTALLATION Ensure 4-Point suspension is properly secured in the hard hat slots as shown. Try on to verify fit.



CENTER STRAP
Ensure the center strap
is completely separated
from the strap disk.
With the center strap
removed, your suspension
is now configured as a
4-point system.
